

Past Tense Continuous (Verlaufsform)

Bildung: Vergangenheitsform von "to be" (was/were) + Verbformen + "ing"

Aussage	Verneinung	Frage
I was working	I wasn't work	Was I working ... ?
he was working	he wasn't work	Was he working ... ?
we were working	we weren't working	Were we working ... ?

Anwendung:

1. Die vorübergehende Dauer der Handlung wird betont:
[We were working all afternoon.]

2. Ein Vorgang dauert an während ein anderer eintritt:
[I was watching the news when you came.]

3a) Bei mehreren Handlungen, die gleichzeitig in der Vergangenheit stattfanden:
[I was watching TV while Tom was doing the dishes.]

3b) Wobei jedoch meist die längere Handlung im Past Continuous steht
und die kürzere im Past Tense:
[Were they waiting when you got there ?]

4) Bei mehreren Vorgängen, die nacheinander in der Vergangenheit stattfanden
wird aber Past Tense verwendet:
[I read the newspaper and then talked to my sister.]
